April 20, 2016

Call to Order

The regular meeting of the Atlantic County Firefighters' Association was called to order at 20:10 on April 20, 2016 at the Atlantic County Anthony "Tony" Canale Training Center by President Amor "Skip" Portale. The meeting was opened with a flag salute followed by an Invocation by the Chaplain of the Association, Reverend Thomas Sweeny. President Portale then pointed out the fire exits and asked that all electronic devices be silenced. President Portale welcomed all to the meeting which serves as the twenty-fifth annual Valor Awards presentation and the seventh annual recognition of firefighters with fifty or more years of active service.

Opening Remarks and Introduction of Host Chief

President Portale thanked the Margate City Fire Department for hosting and introduced Deputy Chief Daniel Adams who reported that Chief Anthony Tabasso was unable to attend due a prior commitment. Deputy Chief Adams welcomed everyone to the annual valor awards and expressed how proud the Margate City Fire Department is to be the official host while also thanking the Atlantic County Firefighters' Association for arranging tonight's program. Deputy Chief Adams offered congratulations to all that will be honored tonight and noted that he is in awe of those that have served fifty years in the fire service.

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Assistant Chief Scott Winneberger, Bayview Volunteer Fire Company, highlighted the details surrounding the September 1, 2015 incident that earned recognition for Captain Scott Tilton.

Awarded to Captain Scott Tilton of the Bayview Volunteer Fire Company who responded to an extrication assignment on the Garden State Parkway. After entering the overturned vehicle, he found the driver with a severed arm. Capt. Tilton applied a tourniquet to the arm and administered a blood clotting medication. The victim was extricated and transported to the hospital.

Chief Walter R. "Butch" Kienzle, III, Egg Harbor City Fire Department, highlighted the details surrounding the October 15, 2014 incident that earned recognition for three members of the Egg Harbor City Fire Department.

They discovered a semi-conscious victim who they were able to remove from the residence. They did not know at the time that there was a natural gas leak in the house.
